3-4 Year Olds: Progressive Learning Outcomes

- ✓ Semi Structured and fun
- ✓ Co-operative games based on fantasy stories e.g. Lion King
- ✓ Simple rules within games
- ✓ Parental Involvement and support where necessary

4-5 Year Olds: Progressive Learning Outcomes:

- ✓ Well structured and fun
- ✓ Balance between co-operative and competitive games
- ✓ Introduction to games with clear rules
- ✓ Intro. to mini soccer games e.g. 3 v 3
- ✓ Minimal on-site parental involvement in games

5-6 Year Olds: Progressive Learning Outcomes

- ✓ Well structured and fun
- ✓ Increasingly competitive games but with emphasis on performance rather than result
- ✓ More developed appreciation of rules
- ✓ Increased range of mini soccer games
- ✓ Increased emphasis on respect for opponents, coach / referee
- ✓ No on-site parental involvement in games
